Lowmead Bridges Replacement - project complete

We're pleased to announce completion of the Lowmead Bridges Replacement project, with Gorge Road - Baffle Creek Crossing works finalised, and the new bridge (pictured right) now open for use.

Your assistance has enabled us to replace two timber bridges with more durable concrete bridges, at John Clifford Way - Hobble Creek Crossing and Gorge Road - Baffle Creek Crossing.

Both bridges will now sustain greater load capacity, increasing load limits to 160T.



Gorge Road - Baffle Creek Crossing is now open to traffic.

Bridge users will experience quieter and smoother travel, in addition to reduced need for bridge maintenance.

As bridge construction is now complete, this will be our last Lowmead Bridges Replacement project information sheet issued.

We thank you for your interest and co-operation throughout this project, which has enabled us to deliver these new bridges as part of our regional bridge improvement works.

The Lowmead Bridges Replacement project has been funded by the Federal Government's Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications' Bridges Renewal Program Round 4 and Gladstone Regional Council.
